SUBJECT: Acquisition of Former Chubb Factory Site, Maerdy Industrial Estate, Ferndale, RCT, CF43 4AB

1. DECISION MADE:

Agreed –

Following the consideration of the report of the Director, Corporate Estates containing exempt information as defined in Paragraph 14 of Part 4 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act, 1972 (as amended), namely information relating to the financial affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information), it was **AGREED:**

1. To purchase the Freehold interest at the Former Chubb Factory site, Maerdy Industrial Estate, Ferndale.

N.B. With the agreement of the Chair, County Borough Councillor P Howe addressed the Cabinet on this item.

2. REASON FOR THE DECISION BEING MADE:

The need to seek authority to acquire the Freehold interest of land comprising the Former Chubb Factory Site, Maerdy Industrial Estate, Ferndale, RCT which is located in a key position adjacent to private and Council land holdings, to potentially facilitate the development of a new Welsh Medium Primary School and/ or develop the site to meet the needs of the local community.
