Dywedwyd bod cynnydd sylweddol wedi bod yn nifer yr Hysbysiadau Digwyddiad Dros Dro (TEN). Roedd hyn yn bennaf oherwydd digwyddiadau a gynhaliwyd ar gyfer Calan Gaeaf, Noson Tân Gwyllt a digwyddiadau a gynlluniwyd ar gyfer adeg y Nadolig. Tynnodd y swyddog sylw hefyd at un safle a oedd wedi defnyddio Hysbysiad Digwyddiad Dros Dro i dreialu gwerthu alcohol mewn bar micro fragdy i brofi hyfywedd gwneud cais am Drwydded Safle.

Dysgodd yr aelodau fod un cais wedi ei herio, sef cais Clwb Platform 11, Pontypridd, lle penderfynodd Aelodau ganiatáu amrywio'r oriau gweithredu ar ddydd Gwener a dydd Sadwrn ond gwrthod caniatáu oriau masnachu ychwanegol ar ddydd Iau. Cafodd Aelodau wybod na chafodd unrhyw adolygiadau nac apeliadau eu cyflwyno ers yr adroddiad diwethaf.

Cyfeiriodd y swyddog yr Aelodau at adran 4.3 yr adroddiad lle mae arolygiadau o safleoedd a thor rheolau'n cael eu hamlinellu. Roedd yr Aelodau'n falch o glywed bod 89% o'r adeiladau a arolygwyd yn cydymffurfio ar y cyfan, o'i gymharu â 79% yn ystod yr un cyfnod yn 2017.

Cafodd Aelodau wybod bod nifer o gwynion wedi eu derbyn yn ystod y cyfnod, gyda'r rhan fwyaf ohonynt yn gysylltiedig â niwsans sŵn. Eglurwyd bod cynnydd yn nifer yr achosion honedig o werthu alcohol i bobl dan oed yn ystod y cyfnod, ond cafodd Aelodau sicrhad bod y rhain wedi cael blaenoriaeth er mwyn sicrhau bod yr Amcan Trwyddedu i 'Ddiogelu Plant rhag Niwed' yn parhau i gael ei fodloni.

Cyflwynodd y swyddog drosolwg i'r Pwyllgor o'r gwaith a gafodd ei gyflawni gan y Garfan Trwyddedu ledled RhCT yn ystod y cyfnod. Roedd y swyddog yn falch o roi gwybod i Aelodau y bu cynnydd yn nifer y bobl sy'n mynychu cyfarfodydd 'Pubwatch' ers y cyfnod diwethaf a bod cyfarfod newydd wedi'i sefydlu yng Nghlwb Hibernian y Gelli sy'n rhoi sylw i safleoedd trwyddedig o'r Pentre i Lwynypïa.

Soniodd y swyddog am gamau cadarnhaol sy wedi cael eu gwneud er mwyn annog pobl ifainc i beidio ag yfed alcohol. Dechreuodd y gwaith yma yn dilyn lansio Partneriaeth Alcohol Gymunedol Pontypridd yn llwyddiannus. Siaradodd y swyddog am y gystadleuaeth Dragons Den a gynhaliwyd yn ddiweddar mewn partneriaeth â Sainsbury's, Pontypridd a Charfan Partneriaeth Ymgysylltu leuenctid y Cyngor. Dywedodd y byddai'r cynlluniau llwyddiannus yn cael eu trafod mewn cyfarfod o'r Pwyllgor Trwyddedu yn y dyfodol. Roedd Aelodau hefyd yn falch o glywed bod y chwe pherson ifanc a oedd wedi cymryd rhan yn y cymhwyster Hyrwyddwr Iechyd Pobl Ifainc wedi llwyddo.

Minutes of the meeting of the Licensing Act 2003 meeting held on Tuesday, 4 December 2018 at 4.30 pm at the Council Chamber, The Pavilions, Cambrian Park, Clydach Vale, Tonypandy, CF40 2XX.

7 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from County Borough Councillors T. Williams, A. Cox and L. Jones.

8 Declaration of Interest

In accordance with the Council's Code of Conduct, there were no declarations made pertaining to the agenda.

9 Human Rights Act 1997 and Crime and Disorder Act

It was **RESOLVED** to note that when Members determine the licensing and registration matters before them, they have a duty not to act in a manner that is incompatible with the convention on Human Rights and the Crime and Disorder Act.

10 Minutes

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the 11th September, 2018 as an accurate reflection of the meeting.

11 Review of the Licensing Act 2003 & Gambling Act 2005

The Head of Public Protection provided the Committee with a quarterly report on relevant issues with regard to the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005, together with ancillary matters arising from the responsibilities charged to the Committee.

It was reported that there had been a significant increase in the number of Temporary Events Notices (TEN's), which was largely due to events held for Halloween, Bonfire Nights and event planned for the approaching Christmas season. The officer also drew attention to the one premises which had utilised a TEN to trial the sale of alcohol at a microbrewery bar to test the viability of applying for a Premises Licence.

Members learned that during the period, there had been one contested application, namely Platform 11 Club, Pontypridd, where Members resolved to grant the variation of hours on Fridays and Saturdays but refused extra trading hours on Thursdays. Members were informed that there had been no reviews or appeals submitted since the last report.

The officer referred Members to section 4.3 of the report where the premises inspections and infringements were outlined. Members were pleased to learn that 89% of premises inspected were broadly compliant compared to the 79% rate during the same period in 2017.

Members were advised that there had been a number of complaints received during the period, most of which were associated with noise nuisance. It was explained that during the period, there had been an increased number of alleged incidents of underage sales but Members were assured that these were prioritised to ensure that the Licensing Objective of 'Protection of Children from Harm' is continued to be met.

The officer provided the Committee with an overview of the work undertaken by the Licensing team across RCT for the period. The officer was pleased to inform Members that since the last period, there had been an increase in attendance at 'Pubwatch' meetings and that a new meeting had been set up in the Gelli Hibernian Club which includes licensed premises from Pentre to Llwynypia.

The officer spoke of positive actions undertaken for young people to steer them away from consuming alcohol, which had been initiated following the successful launch of the Pontypridd CAP. The officer spoke of a recent Dragons Den competition which had taken place in partnership with Sainsbury's, Pontypridd and the Council's Youth Engagement Partnership Team and advised that the successful designs would be brought back to a future meeting of the Licensing Committee. Members were also pleased to learn that all six young people who had participated in the Young Persons Health Champion qualification had passed.

Members were updated on the new PSPO implemented on 1st September, 2018 and were advised that to date, nine people had had alcohol confiscated and were issued with warnings.

In respect of the revised Statement of Principles, under the provisions of the Gambling Act 2005, Members were reminded that the revisions which were endorsed by the Licensing Committee on 11th September, 2018 had been

approved by Council on 28th November, 2018.

One Member raised concerns in respect of the use of TEN's to test the viability of applying for a Premises Licence, namely the recent application in respect of Platform 11, Pontypridd. The Member queried whether officers visit premises following the approval to vary operating hours to ensure that there isn't an increase in anti-social behaviour due to further alcohol consumption. The officer assured the Member that the majority of the TEN's received were for community events, and that there was currently no trend in Licensed Premises using the TEN's as a method to apply to vary their licence. It was stressed to Members that each application would be dealt with on its own merits. The officer explained that following the application from Platform 11, the Licensing team would either visit similar future Temporary Events or visit the premises the following day to monitor the CCTV to ensure they have sufficient evidence prior to any application being brought to the Licensing Sub Committee.

The Member raised concerns in respect of the use of TEN's taking place until the early hours in residential areas, commenting that Public Health should be intervening and contacting the Local Member. The officer explained that early morning sporting events were not unusual and that it was difficult to object to a licensed premises with previously good behaviour as the TEN's Guidance relies heavily on the complaints history.

One Member advised officers that a number of complaints had been received in respect of underage alcohol sales at a licensed premises in Aberdare, and officers agreed to investigate.

It was **RESOLVED:-**

- a) To note the contents of the report in respect of the Licensing Act 2003 and:
- b) To note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005.**

The number of Temporary Event Notices (TEN's) notifications steadily increased as the Christmas and New Year period approached.

In the community, a market selling local produce and crafts in Treorchy utilised TENs for the sale of alcohol in their monthly market whilst they considered the feasibilty of applying for a Premises Licence. Due to the popularity of the market, they have increased their trading to fortnightly and they have attended a pre-application meeting with Licensing, Police Licensing, Trading Standards, Child Protection and Environmental Health with the aim of applying for a premises licence.

As in previous years, a number of supermarkets and local convenience stores used the TENs process to authorise additional trading hours for the sale of alcohol over the Christmas period.

In addition to the familiar fund-raising charity events, there have been Christmas and New Year functions which have used TENs to cover additional entertainment and hours. Some more recent TENs have been utilised for sporting events such as wrestling, coverage of the American Super Bowl, and providing entertainment after the Six Nations rugby.

Analysis of the TEN's applications indicate 28 related to Private Members Clubs, 63 for existing premises licences and 20 permitted community events.

A summary of TEN's, is reproduced for Members information as **Appendix 1A**.

In accordance with the advice received in respect of data protection matters, the summaries of Personal Licences and Premises Licences issued under delegated authority are now reproduced for information as a Part II restricted item.

4.3 Premises Inspection & Infringements

The relevant Performance indicator for the Licensing Team is "the premises licences found to be broadly compliant following inspection by Licensing Officers". Officers will consider confidence in management, compliance with licence conditions and business competency when determining the risk rating of the premises when considering whether they are broadly compliant.

Our current performance indicates that **89%** of premises inspected are broadly compliant.

Officers are currently stepping up efforts to increase inspections. The most recent inspections have been broadly compliant. Those that have issues are being managed by local officers to bring about compliance; should these efforts fail further enforcement action will be considered.

4.4 Complaints, Advice and Guidance

The usual advice has been provided to various applicants seeking to apply, or amend licences. Pre application advice has been provided to a number of applicants.

During this period the Rhondda valley has seen a significant drop in complaints, and those complaints previously received have been resolved. Pub Watch within the area has also seen a decrease in incidents reported to the police. This represents a positive outlook, showing the work being conducted by the licensing officers in building relationships with licence holders is working for the best.

The Rhondda local licensing officer assisted on the police led operation Marsileo within the Porth area, which evolved due to concerns over vulnerable youths. This operation was agreed by the Licencing Department based on the promotion of the objective 'The protection of children from harm'.

During the eveing of the operation a number of premises inspections were conducted. All were compliant apart from the primary premises of concern. Further inspections will be conducted in the near future, as well as monitoring of the premises.

Within the Rhondda the local officer attended a number of licenced premises, accompanied by a trading standards officer, to inspect the layouts of gaming machines and to provide information and advice. This was conducted in line with the Public Health Delivery Plan. No issues or concerns were raised from this activity.

Further to the last Committee Report where it was recorded that there was an increase within the Cynon valley of suspected / alleged under age sales, the local licensing officer has worked well in partnership with external stakeholders to arrange a training course / workshop for staff at licensed premises to attend. The event was held in Mountain Ash Workingmens Club and was attended by staff from various premises in the area. Attendance at the event was voluntary therefore the 16 people who attended showed a definite positive response. This again promotes the positive influence of building relationships between the licensed trade and the Local Authority to combat issues which arise. Feedback from the event was positive.

A Multi Agency pre application meeting was held regarding an application to open a 'unlicensed family entertainment centre' within Aberdare. Due to ongoing concerns within the proposed area the meeting was beneficial to all parties to understand the nature of the business, including the applicant, the licensing authority and the police. Such premises are usually seen at beach fronts and holiday camps.

Pontypridd 'Tumble Area' is the major hotspot for nightlife within RCT. Recently there has been a number of applications by premises to extend trading hours and vary their licences. Due to this the Licensing Committee Chair commented that it may be advantageous to visit the area to understand the scope of the night time economy, and how it impacts on the licencing objectives. As a result, on the evening of Friday the 8th February two officers from the licensing depratment accompanied Committee Members to the area. During the evening members attended the CCTV control room where they viewed cameras and spoke to staff to understand the role they conduct in assisting the police and licensing authority. Members then went on to see the Marshals on the taxi rank, where enforcement officers were conducting checks, and then onto each of the licensed premises within the area. This appeared to be a helpful experience, with members now having a more familiar understanding of the area, and the issues which may rise within.

Complaints have remained persistent regarding one premises within the Cynon area, however this is being managed well by the local licensing officer, and these complaints are now becoming less frequent in nature.

Within the Taff area there are a couple of premises which have had numerous issues, with violent incidents reported to the police being a common theme. The licensing officer has met with the police and discussions are ongoing on how to enforce future action.

One premises within the Tonyrefail area is in the process of enforcment action from South Wales Fire and Rescue Service. The local officer has assisted by producing a written statement.

Officers have assisted the Community Safety Team in conducting visits to licensed premises within Pontypridd town centre as part of the Community Alcohol Project (CAP). This is an ongoing initiative which has received positive feedback from various partners and the community.

Inspections conducted within some of the takeaways with the Tumble area has found issues regarding compliance, most notably lack of CCTV. However, some of these have now been rectified thanks to persistence from the local officer.

The local officer also had to step in to provide advice to a hairdressers within Taffs Well, as a result of the owner renovating the premises and constructing a bar. The premises is not licensed. Advice was provided to the owner and assurances were provided that no alcohol will be sold.

4.5 Prosecutions

There have been no prosecutions during this period, however officers are assisting the Public Health Food Hygiene Team on a potential prosecution by providing statements.

4.6 Public Space Protection Order (PSPO)

The exclusion zones within Aberdare and Pontypridd Town Centres are continuing to be monitored by both local authority staff and police. Pontypridd has seen the majority of instances where action has been instigated, this is usually in the form of confiscation of alcohol.

Aberdare has recently seen an increase in occurences resulting in increased patrols by officers.

During this period officers have proactively taken action to reclaim outstanding debt. This period has seen a large number of premises owing money make payments. Legal advice has also been sought from a reliable and well respected external solicitor, which confirmed our stance. As a result a number of premises have seen their licence suspended until payment is made.

Officers will continue to monitor the premises to ensure they do not trade without licence.
