Dywedwyd bod cynnydd sylweddol wedi bod yn nifer yr Hysbysiadau Digwyddiad Dros Dro (TEN) yn ystod y chwarter. Roedd hyn yn bennaf oherwydd digwyddiadau a gynhaliwyd ar gyfer y Nadolig a Nos Galan.

Dysgodd yr Aelodau fod nifer o geisiadau wedi'u herio ers yr adroddiad cryno diwethaf a bod modd i'r swyddog ddarparu diweddariad mewn perthynas â'r cais am amrywio'r Drwydded Safle ar gyfer Club Ice, Pontypridd. Cadarnhawyd bod yr Is-pwyllgor wedi gwrthod y cais ar gyfer nos lau, ond wedi rhoi'r Drwydded ar gyfer nos Wener a nos Sadwrn. Rhoddwyd yr amrywiad hefyd ar nos Sul i'r eiddo agor i'r cyhoedd rhwng 11:00 a 01:30, gan gyflenwi alcohol rhwng 11:00 a 01:00, yn amodol ar nifer o amodau ychwanegol.

Cafodd Aelodau wybod na chafodd unrhyw adolygiadau nac apeliadau eu cyflwyno ers yr adroddiad diwethaf.

Cyfeiriodd y swyddog yr Aelodau at adran 4.3 yr adroddiad lle mae arolygiadau o safleoedd a thor rheolau'n cael eu hamlinellu. Roedd yr aelodau'n falch o glywed bod 89% o'r adeiladau a arolygwyd yn cydymffurfio'n gyffredinol er bod oedi wedi bod cyn cynnal arolygiadau oherwydd cyfnod y Nadolig.

Cyflwynodd y swyddog drosolwg i'r Pwyllgor o'r gwaith a gafodd ei gyflawni gan y Garfan Drwyddedu ledled RhCT yn ystod y cyfnod. Cafodd y Pwyllgor wybod y bu gostyngiad sylweddol yn nifer y cwynion a dderbyniwyd ar gyfer ardal Cwm Rhondda yn ystod y cyfnod, yn ogystal â gostyngiad mewn digwyddiadau y cafodd yr heddlu wybod amdany'n nhw. Siaradodd y swyddog yn gadarnhaol am 'Ymgyrch Marsileo', a ffurfiwyd yn ardal Cwm Rhondda i sicrhau bod yr Amcan Trwyddedu 'Amddiffyn Plant rhag Niwed' yn cael ei hyrwyddo. Roedd yr Aelodau'n falch o glywed bod pob eiddo trwyddedig, ar wahân i un eiddo sy'n peri pryder, wedi bod yn barod i gydymffurfio yn ystod yr arolygiadau. Dywedodd y swyddog hefyd na chafodd unrhyw bryderon eu codi yn dilyn nifer o archwiliadau i eiddo trwyddedig gan Safonau Masnach er mwyn gwirio lleoliadau peiriannau hapchwarae.

Yn dilyn pryderon a godwyd yn y cyfarfod diwethaf ynghylch y gwerthiannau dan oed honedig yng Nghwm Cynon, roedd yr Aelodau'n falch o glywed bod gweithdy wedi'i gynnal, a bod 16 o bobl wedi cymryd rhan. Roedd hwn yn weithdy gwirfoddol ac roedd yr adborth yn gadarnhaol, felly mae modd cynnig y digwyddiad eto.

Aeth y swyddog ymlaen i siarad am yr ymweliad safle diweddar a gynhaliwyd yn ardal 'Y Tymbl', Pontypridd, lle'r aeth Aelodau o'r Pwyllgor Trwyddedu gyda swyddogion i ymweld â'r ystafell reoli TCC, y safle tacsis a rheolwyr yr eiddo trwyddedig yn y cyffiniau. Cafodd yr Aelodau eu hatgoffa o'u cais i ymweld ag ardal Aberdâr, a nodwyd y byddai'r swyddogion yn ystyried trefnu hyn ar gyfer y dyfodol.

Cafodd yr aelodau y newyddion diweddaraf am y Gorchymyn Gwarchod Mannau Cyhoeddus a oedd wedi'i roi ar waith ar 1 Medi, 2018 a nodwyd bod y parthau gwahardd yng nghanol trefi Pontypridd ac Aberdâr yn parhau i gael eu monitro gan yr heddlu a staff yn yr Awdurdod Lleol. Eglurwyd bod y nifer helaeth o achosion wedi digwydd ym Mhontypridd, lle cafodd alcohol ei atafaelu.

Minutes of the meeting of the Licensing Act 2003 meeting held on Tuesday, 12 March 2019 at 4.30 pm at the Council Chamber, The Pavilions, Cambrian Park. Clydach Vale, Tonypany, CF40 2XX.

#### **14 Declaration of Interest**

In accordance with the Council's Code of Conduct, there were no declarations made pertaining to the agenda.

#### **15 Human Rights Act 1997 and Crime and Disorder Act**

It was **RESOLVED** to note that when Members determine the licensing and registration matters before them, they have a duty not to act in a manner that is incompatible with the convention on Human Rights and the Crime and Disorder Act.

#### **16 Minutes**

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2018 as an accurate reflection of the meeting.

#### **17 Review of the Licensing Act 2003 & Gambling Act 2005**

The Head of Public Protection provided the Committee with a quarterly report on relevant issues with regard to the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005, together with ancillary matters arising from the responsibilities charged to the Committee.

It was reported that there had been a significant increase in the number of Temporary Events Notices (TEN's) during the quarter, which was largely due to events held for the Christmas and New Year period.

Members learned that there had been a number of contested applications since the last summary report and the officer was able to provide an update in respect of the application for variation of the Premises Licence for Club Ice, Pontypridd. It was confirmed that the Sub Committee had refused the request for the Thursday, but granted the Licence for Friday and Saturday. The variation was also granted on the Sunday for the premises to open to the public between the hours 11:00 to 01:30 with the supply of alcohol between 11:00 to 01:00, subject to a number of additional conditions.

Members were informed that there had been no reviews or appeals submitted since the last report.

The officer referred Members to section 4.3 of the report where the premises inspections and infringements were outlined. Members were pleased to learn that 89% of premises inspected were broadly compliant despite there being a delay in inspections due to the Christmas period.

The officer provided the Committee with an overview of the work undertaken by the Licensing team across RCT for the period. The Committee were advised that there had been a significant drop in the number of complaints received for the Rhondda area during the period and a decrease in incidents reported to the police. The officer spoke positive of 'Operation Marsileo' which had been formed in the Rhondda area to ensure the promotion of the Licensing Objective of 'Protection of Children from Harm'. Members were pleased to learn that apart from one premises of concern, all licensed premises had been compliant during the inspections. The officer also advised that no concerns had been raised following a number of inspections to licensed premises by Trading Standards to check the locations of gaming machines.

Members were pleased to learn that following concerns raised at the last meeting regarding the alleged under age sales in the Cynon Valley, a workshop had taken place whereby sixteen people attended. Participation in the workshop was voluntary and feedback was positive therefore the event may be offered again.

The officer went on to speak of the recent site visit held at the 'Tumble' area of Pontypridd, whereby Members of the Licensing Committee accompanied officers to visit the CCTV control room, taxi rank and the management of the licensed premises in the vicinity. Members were reminded of their request to visit the Aberdare area and were advised that officers would look into arranging this for a future date.

Members were updated on the PSPO which had been implemented on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2018 and were advised that the exclusion zones within Pontypridd and Aberdare town centres are continuing to be monitored by police and staff at the Local Authority. It was explained that the majority of instances had taken place in Pontypridd, whereby alcohol had been confiscated.

In respect of the Gambling Act 2005, Members were advised that there were no major changes to the position of recovery of annual fees as a result of the robust legislation which allows for withdrawal of the licence/permit for non-payment of appropriate fees.

One Member raised concerns in respect of the use of TEN's to test the viability of applying for a premises licence. The officer assured the Member that the Licensing department were mindful of businesses using this method and had monitoring in place to ensure they have appropriate evidence prior to any subsequent application to vary a licence being brought to the Licensing Sub Committee.

Members took the opportunity to thank the officers for the insightful visit to the 'Tumble' area of Pontypridd, commenting on the clear CCTV footage and the positive management skills displayed by the premises license holders on the evening.

It was **RESOLVED**:-

- a) To note the contents of the report in respect of the **Licensing Act 2003** and;
- b) To note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005**.

It was **RESOLVED** that the press and public be excluded from the meeting under Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended) for the following items of business on the grounds that they involve the likely disclosure of exempt information as defined in Paragraph 13 of Part 4 of Schedule 12A of the Act.

#### REPORT OF THE DIRECTOR FOR PUBLIC HEALTH, PROTECTION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES.

#### 1. PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

The purpose of the report is to update Members on relevant issues, with regard to

- the Licensing Act 2003
- the Gambling Act 2005

#### 2. RECOMMENDATION

Members are requested to: -

- (i) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Licensing Act 2003** which has been provided for information;
- (ii) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005**, which has been provided for information.

#### 3. BACKGROUND

Members will be aware that a quarterly meeting is convened to review and discuss the implementation and progress of the Licensing Act 2003, together with any ancillary matters arising from responsibilities with which this particular Committee is charged.

Such ancillary matters include the Gambling Act 2005. (There may also be ancillary matters arising from the impact of the Smoke-Free Premises Regulations, which have the potential to affect all licensed premises).

#### 4. LICENSING ACT 2003

##### 4.1 Application Process

Applications received since the last update (18<sup>th</sup> February 2019 to 26<sup>th</sup> May 2019) are as follows:-

The number of Temporary Event Notices (TEN's) notifications are slightly lower than the last report which covered the busy Christmas and New Year period but they do remain steady.

We have had several Bank Holidays at Easter and in May where existing Premises Licences and Club Premises Certificates have used TENs to extend their trading hours and provide additional entertainment.

As the Summer months approach, we are seeing increasing numbers of outdoor events in the community ranging from family fun days, open air markets, and open air cinema events. TENs have been used to permit the sale of alcohol at the University when they have award ceremonies and also for a pop up micropub in the Beddau area which sells real ales, craft beers and cider.

Analysis of the TEN's applications indicate 14 related to Private Members Clubs, 31 for existing premises licences and 44 permitted community events.

A summary of TEN's, is reproduced for Members information as **Appendix 1A**.

**In accordance with the advice received in respect of data protection matters, the summaries of Personal Licences and Premises Licences issued under delegated authority are now reproduced for information as a Part II restricted item.**

### **4.3 Premises Inspection & Infringements**

The relevant Performance indicator for the Licensing Team is "*the premises licences found to be broadly compliant following inspection by Licensing Officers*". Officers will consider confidence in management, compliance with licence conditions and business competency when determining the risk rating of the premises when considering whether they are broadly compliant.

Our current performance level for inspected premises remains at **89%**.

Officers are taking a stepped approach to managing premises who have been identified as not fully compliant. Action plans are being put in place for licence holders to reach compliance and follow up inspections are conducted. Officers are finding engagement with licence holders is the best way in managing issues, with enforcement action being the last avenue.

### **4.4 Complaints, Advice and Guidance**

Officers have been busy providing advice to licence holders and those seeking to submit applications.

Pre application meetings have been conducted for many premises, whether for minor variation or full grant. These have ranged from restaurants, to convenience stores to leisure/entertainment facilities such as a bowling complex. One such pre-application meeting was for an off licence premises in Penrhiwfer – no application has been submitted as yet. This person also wished to open a taxi office within the premises utilising an "Uber style" app.

Advice and guidance was provided to a well established licensee who wishes to hold an Ale and Gin festival in Treorchy, the festival will form part of a larger scale event in the area and the event Safety advisory Group are working together on this event.

Meetings have taken place in relation to Pontypridd Big Weekend, the application for the Time Limited Premises Licence is yet to be submitted however authorities are already working with organisers to ensure a safe and successful event.

Officer time has also been spent advising on TENs such as an open air cinema and charity events.

During this period officers have met with a representative from Public Health Wales to discuss their role as a Responsible Authority.

The number of complaints within this reporting period appear to have dropped which can be viewed as a positive, due to less numbers feeling the need to raise any issues. This is also evidenced in the Upper Rhondda Pubwatch meetings where again it has been noted by those attending that no significant issues have arisen in the area.

However, within Pontypridd Pubwatch meetings, which are well attended, there are people excluded every month from the town centre premises.



The late night refreshment takeaways at the top of Pontypridd town centre (Tumble Area) are continuing to cause concerns for the local officer. These are currently under close scrutiny and the Licensing Authority are considering their position with regards to further enforcement action.

South Wales Police received an anonymous facebook post alleging drug taking in a number of premises in Tonyrefail. All premises involved in the allegations were visited by RCT Licensing and South Wales Police Licensing Officers and given appropriate advice.

An enforcement exercise conducted on the evening of 10<sup>th</sup> May 2019 during which 4 test purchases were attempted due to intelligence received of premises breaching conditions or complaints alleging to open after 23:00hrs; no sales were made confirming the allegations.

Colleagues from trading standards also conducted an evening of test purchases for potential alcohol sales to 'under 18s', again no sales were made.

A premises in the Church Village area has been a concern for the licensing authority for a number of years with various complaints alleged to the authorities. Proactive engagement by our senior licensing officer in partnership with South Wales Police with the owners of the premises has resulted in the cessation of the lease of the DPS who has now left the business. The premises is now closed and undergoing a refurbishment before its re-opening in July.

The Licensing Authority are part of a working group recently set up to discuss the introduction of an Alcohol Treatment Centre in Pontypridd. This will be led primarily by NHS staff, the hope is to alleviate the pressures on A&E departments. Discussions are at an early stage.

Officers have also began a programme of inspections on betting establishments.

The Licensing Authority is currently working on drafting the Licensing Act Statement of Policy, which is due for renewal in January 2020.

#### **4.5 Prosecutions**

The Public Health Food Hygiene Team are currently progressing a prosecution on a late night refreshment takeaway.

#### **4.6 Public Space Protection Order (PSPO)**

The exclusion zones within Aberdare and Pontypridd Town Centres are continuing to be monitored by both local authority staff and police. Pontypridd has seen the majority of instances where action has been instigated, this is usually in the form of confiscation of alcohol.
