At hynny, dydyn ni ddim yn credu bod unrhyw feysydd sydd angen asesiad effaith gronol o fewn Cyngor RhCT ar hyn o bryd. Cyflwynodd y Pennaeth Diogelu'r Cyhoedd a Gwasanaethau Rheoleiddio adroddiad i'r Pwyllgor oedd yn trafod materion perthnasol o ran Deddf Trwyddedu 2003 a Deddf Gamblo 2005 ar gyfer y cyfnod rhwng 20 Mai a 18 Awst 2024, yn ogystal â materion atodol eraill sy'n deillio o gyfrifoldebau'r Pwyllgor.

Cafodd yr Aelodau wybod bod nifer yr Hysbysiadau Achlysuron Dros Dro wedi cynyddu i 133 yn y cyfnod yma o'i gymharu â 104 yn ystod y cyfnod diwethaf. Mae hyn yn arferol ar gyfer cyfnod yr haf pan mae gwyliau, chwaraeon, achlysuron teuluol ac achlysuron elusennol. Dywedwyd hefyd

bod tafarn y Bute Arms wedi gofyn am sawl Hysbysiad o Achlysur Dros Dro i baratoi ar gyfer cais amrywio trwydded. Ar ben hynny, roedd yr Eisteddfod hefyd wedi arwain at wahanol leoliadau'n gofyn am gynnal gweithgareddau sydd angen trwydded ac estyniadau i'w trwyddedau, oherwydd y llif o bobl ychwanegol i'r ardal.

Mae dadansoddiad o'r ceisiadau am Hysbysiadau Achlysuron Dros Dro yn nodi bod 63 wedi'u rhoi i safleoedd sydd â thrwydded eisoes, 51 wedi'u rhoi ar gyfer achlysuron yn y gymuned a 19 wedi'u rhoi i glybiau preifat.

Dyweddodd Pennaeth Diogelu'r Cyhoedd a Gwasanaethau Rheoleiddio bod un cais i Amrywio Trwydded Safle a gafodd ei herio wedi'i gymeradwyo ers adroddiad diwethaf y Pwyllgor ar sail amodau a gynigiwyd gan yr Awdurdodau Perthnasol ynghyd ag amod yn cyfyngu amseroedd gwerthu alcohol (i'w gael oddi ar y safle yn unig) i'r oriau canlynol: rhwng 9am a 9pm ddydd Llun i ddydd Sul. Hefyd, doedd dim adolygiadau nac apeliadau wedi'u penderfynu yn ystod y cyfnod yma.

Cafodd yr Aelodau eu cyfeirio at adran 4.3 yr adroddiad, lle caiff arolygiadau o safleoedd a thor rheolau eu hamlinellu. Yn ôl yr adroddiad, lefel cyflawniad bresennol y safleoedd wedi'u harolygu yw 89.91%.

Dyweddwyd bod bar cudd arddull "speakeasy" newydd wedi agor yn llwyddiannus ym Mhontypridd mewn pryd ar gyfer yr Eisteddfod. Roedd y lleoliad yma'n boblogaidd yn ystod yr ŵyl ac mae perchennog y busnes wedi ymuno â'r cynllun gwarchod tafarndai 'Pubwatch' lleol.

Cafodd yr Aelodau wybod bod ymweliad â chlwb aelodau preifat yn Llantrisant wedi'i gynnal fis Mehefin yn dilyn ymosodiad cas y tu allan i'r eiddo. Cafodd Heddlu De Cymru wybod am yr ymosodiad ac roedden nhw wedi delio ag elfen droseddol y digwyddiad. Rhoddodd Swyddogion Trwyddedu o garfanau'r Awdurdod Lleol a'r heddlu gyngor cynhwysfawr i Ysgrifennydd y Clwb i leddfu'r risg o ddigwyddiad tebyg. Dyw hwn ddim yn leoliad sy'n peri pryderon i'r Awdurdodau, felly cymerwyd hyn i ystyriaeth pan gafodd cyngor ei roi.

Dyweddodd Pennaeth Diogelu'r Cyhoedd a Gwasanaethau Rheoleiddio fod prawf prynu bwyd ar ôl 11pm wedi'i gynnal ar gyfer siop sy'n gwerthu bwyd parod yng nghanol tref Pontypridd yn dilyn cwyn am werthu bwyd poeth ar ôl yr awr derfynol. Ar ben hynny, mae perchennog y busnes eisoes wedi derbyn cyngor swyddogion ac wedi bod i swyddfeydd y Cyngor o'r blaen am gyngor cyn ymgeisio, felly mae camau pellach yn cael eu hystyried.

Cafodd yr Aelodau wybod bod swyddogion wedi ymweld â lleoliad ar y cyd â Safonau Masnach yn dilyn nifer o gwynion am ymddygiad gwrthgymdeithasol, gwerthu nwyddau i bobl dan oed ac achosion honedig o gamddefnyddio a gwerthu cyffuriau. Dywedwyd hefyd bod cyngor wedi'i roi a bod deiliad y drwydded a'r Goruchwyliwr Safle Penodedig wedi rhoi mesurau ar waith, wedi gosod camerâu teledu cylch cyfyng ac arwyddion

y tu allan, yn monitro'r ardal awyr agored, a bod cytundeb i gau giataiau pan mae'n brysur. Bydd hyn yn parhau i gael ei fonitro.

Cafodd yr Aelodau wybod bod swyddogion wedi chwarae rhan fawr yn y broses gynllunio ar gyfer yr Eisteddfod ac wedi mynychu llawer o gyfarfodydd y Grŵp Cynghori ar Ddiogelwch Achlysuron drwy gydol y flwyddyn i sicrhau cydymffurfiaeth â'r ddeddfwriaeth drwyddedu. Yn ystod 8 diwrnod yr achlysur, aeth Swyddogion Trwyddedu i Faes A, Maes B, a chanol y dref i ymweld â llawer o'r lleoliadau trwyddedig presennol, gan gynnig arweiniad a chynghor yn ôl yr angen. Ar ben hynny, mae'n braf dweud taw ychydig iawn o broblemau mân oedd wedi codi yn ystod yr achlysur ac mae'r lleoliadau yng nghanol y dref wedi nodi ffigurau masnach rhagorol yn ystod yr ŵyl.

8 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absences were received from County Borough Councillors S. Bradwick and D. Evans.

9 DECLARATION OF INTEREST

In accordance with the Council's Code of Conduct, there were no declarations made pertaining to the agenda.

10 HUMAN RIGHTS ACT 1998 AND CRIME AND DISORDER ACT

It was **RESOLVED** to note that when Members determine the licensing and registration matters before them, they have a duty not to act in a manner that is incompatible with the convention on Human Rights and the Crime and Disorder Act.

11 MINUTES

It was **RESOLVED** to approve the minutes of the 4th June 2024 as an accurate reflection of the meeting.

12 REVIEW OF LICENSING POLICY STATEMENT 2024 - 2030

The Assistant Licensing Manager provided the Committee with the report which is to consider revisions proposed by the Director of Public Health, Protection & Community Services to the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy for the period 2025 – 2030.

Members were advised that following acceptance at licensing committee on 4th June 2024 to engage in consultation, the draft licensing policy was open to comment between 10th June and 21st July 202, whereby the consultation was publicised in local newspapers, on the RCT consultation page, on RCT social media and direct to Responsible Authorities. Furthermore, that two Responsible Authorities commented, these being South Wales Police and Public Health Board, and also, there were 79 respondents to the general questionnaire online.

It was reported that consideration has been given to the police comments, and a number of minor amendments have been made to document, and also, that consideration was given to other comments within the police representation, including a query relating to a cumulative impact assessment (CIA) and late-night levy. Furthermore, that RCT Council does not currently have any areas which are believed to require a cumulative impact assessment, and to introduce this would require significant evidence of issues that do not promote the licensing objectives, which will take some time to gather from all Responsible Authorities as well as other departments such as Community Safety Officers. To date no request has been provided to warrant research into whether there is a need for a CIA.

Following consideration of the report, Members **RESOLVED**;

1. To note the responses received during the consultation period.
2. To agree the proposal of the Director of Public Health & Protection to submit the updated report to Full Council.

13 REVIEW OF THE LICENSING ACT 2003 & GAMBLING ACT 2005

The Head of Service for Public Protection and Regulatory Services provided the Committee with the report on relevant issues with regard to the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005 for the 20th May 2024 to 18th August 2024 together with ancillary matters arising from the responsibilities charged to the Committee.

Member were advised that the number of TEN's have increased this period to 133 compared to 104 during the last reporting, which is usual for the summer period where festivals, sporting events, family events and charity events occur. Also, that the Bute Arms requested several TENS in preparation for a variation application to their licence. Furthermore, that the Eisteddfod also led to various premises requesting licensable

activities and extensions to their licence, due to the influx of those attending the area.

An analysis of the TEN's applications indicates, 63 for existing premises licences, 51 for permitted community events and 19 from Private Members Clubs.

The Head of Service for Public Protection and Regulatory Services reported that since the last Committee report, there had been one contested application for a Variation of Premises Licence which was Granted subject to the addition of the conditions proposed by the RA's along with the restriction of the sale of alcohol (off sales only) to Mon-Sun – 09:00hrs to 21:00hrs. Also, that no reviews and no Appeals have been determined during this period.

Members were referred to section 4.3 of the report, where the premises inspections and infringements were outlined. It was reported that the current performance level for inspected premises which is at 89.91%.

It was report that a new “speakeasy” hidden bar has successfully opened in Pontypridd, in time for the Eisteddfod and this premises was popular during the event timeframe and the owner of the business has joined the local Pubwatch scheme.

Members learned that a private members club in Llantrisant was visited in June following a nasty assault outside the premises, which South Wales Police were alerted to the assault and dealt with the criminal element of this, while Licensing Officers from both Local Authority and Police teams gave full advice to the Club Secretary to mitigate the risk of this happening again. Also, that this is not a premises the Authorities have any concerns with, and this was taken into account when advice was given.

The Head of Service for Public Protection and Regulatory Services reported that the following complaint, a takeaway premises in Pontypridd town centre has been subject to a test purchase of hot food after 23:00hrs, where they sold hot food past the terminal hour. Furthermore, that the owner of this business has been given advice from officers and has been to the Council offices for pre application advice previously, and therefore further action is now being considered.

Members were informed that a joint visit with Trading Standards was conducted at a premises following a number of complaints of anti-social behaviour, underage sales and alleged drug use/dealing. Also, that advice given and PLH/DPS has put measures in place, CCTV installed outside, regular monitoring outside, signage outside and agreement to close gates when busy. This will continue to be monitored.

Members were advised that officers have been heavily involved with the planning process for the Eisteddfod and attended many Safety Advisory

Group meetings throughout this year to ensure compliance with licensing legislation. Also, that during the 8 days of the event, in addition to attending both Maes A and Maes B, Licensing Officers attended the town centre and visited many of the existing licensed premises, offering guidance and advice when necessary. Moreover, that it is pleasing to report that there were minimal minor issues throughout the event and the town centre premises have reported excellent trade figures during the event.

In terms of the recovery of annual fees, Members were advised that the outstanding invoices are a common place and will be chased by officers. Members may note that the date of the above is July. The above figures will alter by the next committee.

The Head of Service for Public Protection and Regulatory Services referred Members to section 5.1 of the report and provided them with an update in terms of the Gambling Act 2005.

Furthermore, Members were provided a summary of existing permissions in relation to Trade profile Gambling.

Following consideration of the report, the Committee **RESOLVED**:

1. **PURPOSE OF THE REPORT**

The purpose of the report is to update Members on relevant issues, with regard to

- **the Licensing Act 2003**
- **the Gambling Act 2005**

2. **RECOMMENDATION**

Members are requested to: -

- (ii) note the contents of the report in respect of the **Gambling Act 2005**, which has been provided for information.

3. **BACKGROUND**

Members will be aware that a quarterly meeting is convened to review and discuss the implementation and progress of the Licensing Act 2003, together with any ancillary matters arising from responsibilities with which this Committee is charged.

Such ancillary matters include the Gambling Act 2005. (There may also be ancillary matters arising from the impact of the Smoke-Free Premises Regulations, which have the potential to affect all licensed premises).

4. **LICENSING ACT 2003**

4.1 **Application Process**

Applications received since the last update (19th August 2024 to 17th November 2024) are as follows:-

Figures are slightly down (206 last time now 170). Personal Licence applications remain steady. The largest increase is the rise in transfers and Vary DPS applications, there is no specific reason for this. TENs have slightly decreased compared to the period, though further requests are expected as the festive period approaches.

TENs have been submitted for the usual charity events, sporting activities, increase in trading hours on licensed premises. With TENs in for Halloween and Bonfire Night, the focus is now on Christmas fayres, markets and such events in the community and increasing hours for shops, pubs & clubs.

An analysis of the TEN's applications indicates, 32 for existing premises licences, 38 for permitted community events and 11 from Private Members Clubs.

A summary of TEN's is reproduced for Members information as **Appendix 1A**.

In accordance with the advice received in respect of data protection matters, the summaries of Personal Licences and Premises Licences issued under delegated authority are now reproduced for information as a Part II restricted item.

4.2 Contested Applications

There have been no contested applications determined during this current reporting period.

4.3 Premises Inspection & Infringements

The relevant Performance indicator for the Licensing Team is "*the premises licences found to be broadly compliant following inspection by Licensing Officers*". Officers will consider confidence in management, compliance with licence conditions and business competency when determining the risk rating of the premises when considering whether they are broadly compliant.

The current performance level for inspected premises is 90.21% which is an increase on the previous reporting period. This is positive, however some inspection found non-compliance on the initial visit, but through advice and follow up visits from officers, compliance was affected.

4.4 Complaints, Advice, Guidance & Information

- An allegation has been received that a grocery store in Treforest is conducting sales of alcohol without a licence and selling counterfeit alcohol. A joint visit is planned with trading standards officers.
- A licensed premises in Llanharry has been reported to the department for allegedly conducting underage sales. Further investigation required.

- A pub in Treforest has been alleged to allow 'stop-ons' beyond their licensed conditions. There have also been complaints of noise nuisance from the beer garden. A licensing officer is conducting enquiries.
- A licensed premises in Efail Isaf is subject to ongoing complaints of noise nuisance to music. This investigation has been forward to the Environmental Pollution team.
- There have been several issues with a premises in the centre of Pontypridd. South Wales Police and Licensing officers have conducted joint visits to offer advice to the DPS of the premises.
- Officers have identified an absent DPS for the 2nd time this year at a premises in Pontyclun. Much advice has been offered to the management and we are now able to move forward with a new licensee.
- The 'Rickards' pub in Treforest has changed ownership. The licensing Authority wish to thank the outgoing premises holder, Mr Rob Otley, for hosting Treforest Pubwatch meetings for the past 15 years or so.
- A stall within Pontypridd Market has received pre-application advice, following a request to sell alcohol with lunches.
- A premises within the Beddau area has no current DPS due to being taken over by a charity. The premises is struggling, and the Charity is trying to maintain its status. No sales of alcohol a currently permitted due to no DPS, however other licensable activities are still ongoing.
- A premises in Llantwit Fardre was subject of a noise complaint from a local resident. Mediation was held between both parties and advice was offered to the premises. The complainant is now satisfied.
- The old Corner Park Garage site on the A4119 in Llantrisant is looking to open as a large store, with alcohol sales. A pre application advice meeting was held with several Responsible Authorities present. We await an application.
- A Halloween party was held at a premises in Treorchy, with up to 200 12–18-year-olds present. The event became completely out of control due to social media posts, there were no door staff only 2 staff members working, one being the DJ. Advice meeting held with LA, SWP and new PLH/DPS of the premises where it was agreed that a Minor Variation application would be submitted to update the Premises Licence. PLH admitted that it was out of control and had learned not to do anything similar again.
- Preparations are ongoing for the 'switch-on' of Christmas light in Aberdare on 1st December. A Time Limited premises licence is in place for music, and TENS for sale of alcohol in car park of Market Tavern.

- A premises in Aberaman has recently been granted a new premises licence (the previous one having lapsed). There were several resident objections and concerns from local Councillors, made through mediation the applicant agreed to reduce trading times and adopt strict conditions in order for the licence to be granted. The premises intends to reopen very shortly.
- There has been a 4th change of DPS this year, at a premises in the centre of Aberdare Bush. Officers will maintain observations on the premises to identify why this has been so frequent.
- A Personal licence course held in Harlequins Bowls Club on 23rd October. This was run externally, but had input from a licensing officer. It was well attended, with all 21 attendees passing.
- During a routine inspection, officers identified there was an absent DPS at a store in Nantgarw. Alcohol was removed from sale /display. An officer has since revisited, but still no DPS present, though enquiries found that no alcohol sales had since been conducted.

The high number of outstanding invoices are regular for this time of the year due to coinciding with the anniversary of when The Licensing Act 2003 came into force, at which time large volumes of licences were issued. Hence, their annual fees are due at this time. Officers are actively engaged in chasing these payments and Members should see this figure greatly reduced by the next report.
