**13        YNYSANGHARAD WAR MEMORIAL PARK - HERITAGE LOTTERY FUND (HLF) PARK FOR PEOPLE PROGRAMME**

The Head of Leisure, Parks and Countryside provided Members with an update on the design proposals in respect of the RIBA stage 3 design for the Horticultural Centre, following Consultation with Cadw and other key stakeholders.

Members discussed the two options before them and the cost variation between each option, with the Head of Service confirming that the costs were still an estimate at this stage of the design. Members discussed the need for further work to be undertaken by officers to explore further funding opportunities.

Members also commented that going forward sample materials proposed to be utilised in the design options would provide further clarity for Members and key stakeholders / consultees. The Head of Service advised that this would be feedback to the consultants.

Following a query the Head of Service advised Members of the planning process going forward with the designs needing to be formally submitted for a future planning application, which would also need to go Welsh Government for determination.

Members discussed taking forward Option 1, in line with the feedback of Cadw and other key stakeholders although asked for flexibility where possible in respect of some of the design options. Members also spoke of the importance of gaining wider public feedback in respect of the proposals going forward.

Members asked to be kept up-to-date with the application as and when appropriate.

Following discussions it was **RESOLVED**:

1. To commence with 'Option 1' of the RIBA Stage 3 designs proposals subject to flexibility with the design options where necessary.
